- 8. How does Nehemiah go about constructing his prayer for Jerusalem?
- 9. What's the ratio between the length of time Nehemiah prayed and the time it took to rebuild the city walls? What does that tell us?
- 10. What action does prayer call us to? See Psalm 27:14
- 11. What kind of success does he pray for?
