- 7. Bob noted that Paul's command to rejoice in the Lord in Philippians 4:4 is a present tense imperative. Can someone in your group explain that? Do you think joy comes naturally or is it something you have to fight for, or what?
- 8. What was Paul's experience rejoicing in awful circumstances? In Bob's message he acted out a number of instances where Paul responded and rejoiced by saying, 'Hey'. Anyone remember some of these?
- 9. Along that line how did bob relate the idea of "Aloha" to rejoicing in the Lord? Philippians 4:4.
- 10. What does it mean that "the Lord is near?" How does that help?
