6. What were the specific "Don'ts" Timothy was to stay away from, and what were the "Do's" Paul call him to embrace and throw himself into?
7. What's involved in being a godly role model?
8. When you hear that a singularly gifted church leader has fallen into immorality, how do you react? How should we react?
