Look back at the Summer Series and share how one or more of these stories has impacted you.

This story is unique in many ways and especially as it spans centuries. By way of review, who was Korah and what motivated him to rebel against Moses and Aaron?

What "grace" notes did God offer Korah and the rebels? How did the story end?

The Rest of the Story

People will spend serious time and money discovering who their ancestors are; and then spend more time and money covering it up. Are you related to anyone famous or infamous?

400 years pass and once again Korah's infamous name pops up. This time it's a group of Korah's descendants. Who were the key Korahites?

Where did they work? What were their tasks and what's so surprising about all this? See 1 Chronicles 6:31-33; 9:19, 22-23, 26, 31-33; 15:15-17, and 1 Chronicles 16:41-42.

These men were distantly (16 generations removed) but directly related to one the nation's greatest criminals. Who hired them to such prominent positions?

What would you advise someone in charge of hiring if an infamous person's relatives wanted a place in your company?

Why do you think they wanted to or were willing to be known as "The Sons of Korah"? What do we remember the Sons of Korah for today? See the superscriptions of Psalms 42, 44-49, 84-85, & 87-88.

Look at one of their psalms, Psalm 46. How do Korah's sons see God differently than their great great...grandfather? **OVER**

What's the point of the story? What does this say to you about God working in your extended family?
