10. Since we all are living stones in God's building (1 Peter 2:7), what is the strength that your stone adds and what strength does your small group bring?
11. What's the problem with being a living stone?
12. If we are all stones being built into a new holy temple what happens when one of us says, "I don't need other stones"?
13. How does this idea of being God's temple impact you?
