

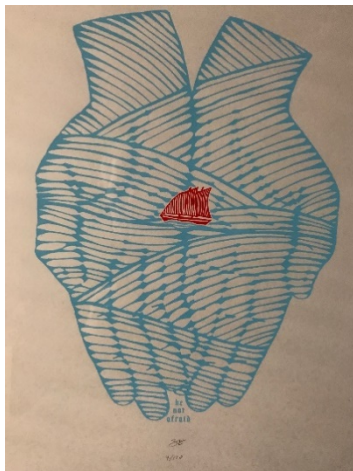
**Series: JESUS IS THE SUBJECT**

4. How would you respond to people who say that this passage and others teach that, "if you have enough faith, God will get you out of any problem?" How does the story of the mustard seed help here? Read John 16:33.
5. Where does peace come from when disaster strikes? How would you respond to someone who loves Jesus and just doesn't have peace when his or her world comes apart? What is peace?
6. The story ends with God having the last question, not us. What's on God's mind as we face terrifying events? How would knowing those questions ahead of time that help?
