3. What stood out in the video?
4. Of all the people Jesus could have chosen to take the gospel to parts unknown, why would he chose Saul, later known as Paul? Isn't it risky to choose a spiritual terrorist to be your chief communications officer?
5. Think about some of the "least likely" kinds of people to stand for Jesus? Name their professions or describe what they do that hinders or harms the work of God. How should we respond to them? When Jesus gets their heart, how should we respond then?
6. Ephesians is not like other books/letters Paul wrote. He doesn't greet anyone by name. He doesn't discuss pressing problems or celebrate their joys, nor does he give personal updates on his work. Was Paul just unfriendly? What's different/unique about this letter/book?
7. What made Ephesus such a critical place to bring the good news? Read Acts 19:1, 8-10, and 35. How does the movie, "The gods must be crazy" illustrate what made it famous?
8. Looking at 1 Corinthians 16:8-9; 2 Corinthians 1:8-9; and Acts 19:23-28, what was behind the gospel's progress and its opposition?
9. Looking at and Acts 20:18-21, do we modern Christ-followers need to emphasize repentance more, along with faith in Christ as we share our faith? If so, how so?
10. What do you think needs to happen here to see our spiritual landscape altered?
