OUR ETERNAL GOD

1. Read 1 Timothy 1:17, Revelation 1:8, and John 8:58. Define “eternal” in the context of the truth that God is eternal.
2. As finite humans, what causes roadblocks in our minds when trying to understand God’s attribute of being eternal? What can we do to remove these roadblocks?
3. What does the statement that “God lives in the eternal NOW” mean?
4. Even though He’s “seen it all, done it all” God comes down and chooses to walk with us through our moments because of His great love for us. In what ways does God’s eternity touch personally you?

OUR INFINITE GOD

1. Define the word “infinite.” Give an example of something that is truly unlimited.
2. Read Isaiah 40:25. Why is the fact that God is infinite one of the most difficult attributes of God to grasp?
3. Do you have a memory of the reflection of the moon moving with you? If so, share your memory with the group.
4. How does the story of the reflection of the moon light demonstrate God directing His love towards you? Why is He able to love you as if you were the only one to be loved? Reference Jeremiah 31:3.

OUR IMMUTABLE GOD

1. Without giving names, describe someone you've known who changes their mind a lot. How has that person's tendency to "flip-flop" affected you?
2. Read Micah 3:6. Because He is immutable, God does not, will not and cannot change. How do you rely on this truth about God? Does this give you comfort as a child of God? If so, in what way?
3. How can you live with a greater awareness of God's unchanging nature in your day-to-day life?

MISCELLANEOUS

1. Applying the truths about God discussed above, we learned the only the only proper response we should have is "WOW-ship." Not only should we have a heart of worship, but live a life of worship. What are some ways you can be intentional about "WOW-ship" this coming week?
2. What would you like to discuss from this message not addressed in the questions above?
3. What is your biggest take-away from this message?
4. What can you do this week, even with today's current "social-distancing" environment, to stay engaged with the body of Christ?
