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OMNIPOTENCE - ALL POWERFUL

Read *Jeremiah 32:17* aloud together. "Oh, Sovereign LORD, you have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you." BTW, that could be a great thing to say first thing in the morning!

1. Read Isaiah 40:26 as it beautifully describes God's power. Describe a time when you realized God is truly, all powerful.
2. Does knowing God is all-powerful create fear, awe, both, something in between, or something else in you?
3. How can knowing that God is omnipotent change our everyday life? Specifically how would it change the way you pray, and the way you handle worry? How can you remind yourself of that?
4. Pastor Bryon mentioned a very slight asterisk could be attached to omnipotence, why? If He is truly omnipotent, what can't he do?

OMNISCIENCE - ALL KNOWING

1. Read Psalm 139:1-6, 13-16 and Isaiah 40: 14-15, 28-31. Pastor Bryon stated a mind-boggling truth: "God was the beginning of what to know before there was something to be known." What does knowing that God knew you even before you were born, knows every moment of your life and how long you will live, mean to you?
2. Bryon stated that a recent survey suggests the number one driving desire in people's lives is to "be known." It barely beat out love. Define what you think the desire to "be known" means. Is trusting that He is all knowing easy or difficult for you to embrace in your life?
3. How does realizing that God knows everything change the way you relate to people who mistreat you?

OMNIPRESENCE - ALL PRESENT

1. Read Psalm 139:7-10. Since God is fully and completely with all people, in all places, at all times, how would this change how you act and what you do?
2. What difference would it make if God were not fully present everywhere? Would that affect your relationship with Him and your daily living? OVER...

3. If God is omnipresent, do we need to ask him to “be with us” in our worship services? When we pray that what do you think they want to happen?

1. What would you like to discuss from this message not addressed in the questions above?
2. What is your biggest take-away?
