

MOSES SERIES - It's Your Calling

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Read Exodus 3:10-14 and 18, and 4:10-17

1. Describe a time when you had to do something that was way out of your comfort zone. (This could be something big or little).
2. Moses became known throughout history as the lawgiver. Does God's "calling" apply just to average, ordinary, imperfect people or only to leaders like Moses?
3. As a member of Pharaoh's court, hadn't Moses been trained to lead on a national level? Why would he balk when his time came? What reasons did he give to disqualify himself and what other reasons could he given?
4. Is feeling inadequate a prerequisite for serving God?
5. Back in Exodus 3:11-14, what did God do to get Moses to accept his calling?
6. Read Ephesians 2:10. From that passage Pastor Bryon mentioned that, "When God calls there's always an "unrecognized preparation." What were some things expected and surprising, that God did to prepare Moses for this role?
7. Hebrews 10:24 tells us, "let us spur one another on to love and good works." What do you sense God has called you to do and how have you seen him prepare you to do that? AND- Are you sensing his call these days? OVER...
8. In Exodus 3:13 -14 God reveals his name as, "I AM THAT I AM". The name indicates that God is eternal and that he cannot be compared to any one thing, such as represented by an image of anything in the cosmos or restricting him to one attribute. How would hearing that unique name help Moses?
