JOB DESCRIPTION

Oversight and leadership of Explorers League Children's Ministry for Skagit Campus.

- Ensure Explorers League consistently reflects the ministry's mission: "Inspiring children to develop a lifelong relationship with Jesus."
- Recruit, lead and inspire volunteers and organize and maintain a schedule for serving during weekend services (and serve, as needed).
- Understand and implement the Orange curriculum and culture.
- Coordinate with Children's Ministry team at the Bellingham campus for Skagit campus supplies and ministry-wide initiatives and events.
- Lead the charge of strengthening Cornwall Skagit's families – helping the church partner with parents and kids through intentional events and education.

Oversight and leadership of Edge Middle School Ministry for Skagit Campus.

- Ensure Edge consistently reflects its core values: Jesus, acceptance, relevance and relationships.
- Serve as primary teacher/organizer for midweek group gatherings.
- Recruit, lead and inspire volunteers to help create a safe space for middle school students to learn about and build a relationship with Jesus.
- Visioncast ministry seasons, teaching series, retreats, special events and Go&Be initiatives.
- Maintain on-going and open connection with students and parents.

Additionally, based on gifting, experience and passion, this position could include involvement in Go & Be (leading our effort to build bridges and relationships within the Skagit community and beyond with a goal of making long-lasting impact through missional work) or College Ministry (creating and executing a vision for reaching the college students in our community at Skagit Valley College and those that commute to Bellingham universities).

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Meetings: with Campus Pastor, Bellingham Children's Ministry Pastor and Bellingham Children's Ministry team (weekly) and Skagit Staff and All-Staff meeting (monthly).
- Confidentiality – keeping shared personal or leadership-level details in strict confidence.
- Weekend services – attending/serving before, during and after services, as needed.
- Attending/serving at Cornwall special services/events.
- Candidate should have a mature commitment to Christ and the ability to maintain a good working relationship with all co-workers and the general public, have an agreement with Cornwall Church policy and procedures as outlined in the staff handbook and exhibit attributes of flexibility, leadership, organization, attention to detail, being a team player and forward thinking.
