1. Why would a pastor/church “transcend” politics in such a critical political season?
2. How political was Jesus in his ministry and how could or should his model impact the church today?
3. What does transcendent mean and where do you see that in Daniel 7:14? Now that the election is over, how does that ‘kingdom confidence’ effect your attitude towards the future?
4. How did the story of the Leonid meteor shower (see Revelation 6:13) help Abraham Lincoln in the 1860 election and what’s the take away for us today?
5. Paul tells us in Philippians 3:20 that “Our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ.” How would someone know if they were more interested in an earthly political party than the kingdom of God? How have you kept yourself from going overboard this political cycle? How hard has that been? What helped? On the other hand, shouldn’t Christians stand up for what is right?
6. Almost everyone has eagerly awaited the outcome of the election. How can we put that same eagerness into eagerly awaiting the arrival of the ultimate “President”?
7. Looking at 1 Peter 2:11-12 what are some ways you’ve found to live well with people who see politics differently than you do?
8. “I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone – for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.” 1 Timothy 2:1-4. It’s time to keep praying for our leaders so ask God to help and bless them.
