5. How did she worship Jesus? What does she teach us about worship? Would Jesus be able to recall you ever offering him extravagant worship?
6. How would you react if you were hosting and this extraordinary thing happens at your house?
7. How much sin must one commit, or how badly must one sin, to be considered a sinner?
8. How does this parable differ from others? How are two men in the story alike and dislike?
9. How does the amount of our debt and the awareness of it, impact us? Similarly, what makes someone blind and self-deceived?
10. On a scale of 1-10 how good are you at recognizing that God "picks up the tab" for you, and for others?
