Week Three

2 Kings 5:1-14

Naaman chooses to go God's way and dip in the river, even though it is hard to do.

Week Four

2 Chronicles 34

King Josiah tells others to go God's way, even though he is young.

Week Five

Judges 7:1-8

Gideon trusts that God's way is perfect, even though it does not make sense at the time.

DAILY CUES



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! Who's ready to wake up and go God's way?"



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, tell your child which way you need to go in order to get where you're going. Ask your child what would happen if you went the wrong way. (You would not get where you need to go.) Talk about how God's way is perfect. That means God's way is never ever wrong. God's way will always be the best way and will get us where God wants us to go.



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, Your way is always perfect. That means Your way will always be the right way. Help us to know what Your way is and then choose to go Your way. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

Add a toy to bath time. Use a bath crayon to draw an arrow on the tub showing your child which way the toy can go. Wipe away the arrow and draw another one going the opposite direction. Change up the arrow a few times during bath time while your child plays with the toy, making it follow the arrow. Talk about how God tells us the right way to go, too, but it's up to us to choose to go God's way.

Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! God made another beautiful day for us to go His way!"



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, take turns naming things you see that God made. Talk about how God made a perfect world and put Adam and Eve in charge of it. And just like Adam and Eve, we have the choice to go God's way or our way.



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for all of the people at church that teach [name of child] that Your way is perfect. Help me to live like I believe Your way is perfect so I can teach [name of child] that truth here at home. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

Add plastic fruit and flowers to bath time along with a small watering can. Encourage your child to use the watering can to "make it rain" on the fruit and flowers so they can grow. Talk about how God made all of the fruit trees, plants, and flowers when He made the world.

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your baby's room, pick them up and say, "Good morning, sweet [name of baby]! I am so glad God made you and let me be your [mom/dad]."



Feeding Time

While feeding your baby this month, look them in the eyes and say, "God made you from the top of your perfect little head all the way down to the bottom of your perfect little toes, because God's way is perfect."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your baby and pray, "Dear God, thank You for [name of baby]. As (he/she) grows up, help me celebrate the wonderful way in which You made [him/her]. Help me to recognize the gifts and abilities You gave [him/her]. And please, help me teach [him/her] to go Your way, because Your way is perfect. I love You, God. In Jesus' name. amen."



Bath Time
