1 Kings 18


God sends fire on the altar as an answer to Elijah's prayer and shows that He is the one true God.

DAILY CUES



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! I want to give my [name of child] a great, big hug because God loves us with a great, big love!"



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, take turns saying the two sentences of the memory verse. For example, you say, "I trust in God." And your child says, "I am not afraid." And then you both say, "Psalm 56:11." Now switch and say it all again! Talk about how every person feels afraid sometimes, but when we trust God, we don't have to stay afraid.



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for loving us and using us in Your plan. It doesn't matter how big or small we are. It's all about You and what You can do. And You can use [name of child] and me, no matter what. You are awesome, God, and we love You. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

As you bathe your child, ask them, "Can you blow bubbles in the water? Can you tap the top of the water with your hands? Can you scoop and pour the water? Can you put your head under the water?" Then say, "Wow! You can do a lot of things. But guess what! God can do ANYTHING! It's true! That's one of the reasons we can trust God. God can do anything!"

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! I see a big [name of child] smile! Do you know why [name of caretaker] is smiling? (*pause*) Because God loves you and me SO much!"



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, take turns naming things that make you feel afraid. Say the memory verse together, "I trust in God. I am not afraid" (Psalm 56:11). Talk about how we don't have to be afraid when we trust God.



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for another amazing day with [name of child]. Thank You for teaching us about how we can trust You. Please help [name of child] and me to always trust Your plans because Your plans are always best. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

Add blocks to bath time. Encourage your child to stack them on the edge of the tub, count to seven, and then knock them down. Talk about how Joshua trusted God and followed His plan. And it worked! The wall around Jericho fell down! Talk about how we can trust God's plan for us, too.

Say This

Who can trust God? *You can trust God.*

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your baby's room, pick them up and say, "Good morning, [name of baby]! Today is a great day because God loves [name of baby] and God loves [name of caretaker]!"



Feeding Time

While feeding your baby this month, look them in the eyes and say, "[Name of caretaker] can trust God and [name of baby] can trust God. We can trust God because He loves us SO much!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your baby and pray, "Dear God, thank You for loving me so much that You sent Jesus. A love like that deserves my trust. Help me to trust You so [name of baby] can watch me and learn to trust You. I love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

While giving your baby a bath, show them how to pat the top of the water with their hands. Say one word of "God loves you" each time you pat the water together.
