## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- READ Psalm 103: 1-12
  - As we read this psalm, we get a glimpse of David preaching to himself. Why is self-talk as part of your spiritual journey a healthy rhythm?
  - As you read Verse 2, what is David reminding himself to not forget? What are the things that cause us to forget the good things God has done for us?
  - David lists that the LORD is compassionate, gracious, slow to anger and abounding in love. He is all these attributes simultaneously, but which one characteristic stands out to you and why?
  - Why is compassion critical in our relationship with Jesus?
  - David illustrates God's compassion with infinite distances (see Psalm 103:11; see Psalm 139: 1-12). How do these analogies encourage you in your own walk with God? Why?
  - For each person, what do **you** know *to be true* about God today?
