God says that whatever you are walking through, you are not alone, “be strong and courageous” for God is with you!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- When Moses was in his final days, God told the Israelites that Joshua would be their new leader. After leaving Egypt and having a steady leader for so long, the Israelites and Joshua were a little unsure of how things would look going forward without Moses. Have you ever had a season where you look around and are unsure where God is going with everything, and you have to lean on Him while reminding yourself to be strong and courageous in Him? What happened?
 - What does it mean to you to fear the Lord?
 - When you pray, how often are you praying that even if God does not give you what you want or think you need, you also pray that regardless of it all, God is enough? How might you pray differently into your current circumstance?
 - Pastor Bob shared a quote from Oswald Chambers, “When you fear God, you fear nothing else, whereas if you do not fear God, you fear everything else.” What is your initial reaction hearing this quote?
 - What does God being WITH you, mean in your walk with Him?

NEXT STEPS

Think about one life situation you are facing currently, whether it be a difficult relationship or a circumstance that is challenging. Write out Joshua 1:9 on a sticky note/card and put it where it is visible to you this week (i.e. bathroom mirror, kitchen sink, dashboard of your car, etc.). Pray this verse at least one time a day (out loud is best) over what you are struggling with and believe that our Jehovah God is with you each hour of the day! If you can memorize it that’s even better!
