Summary of Essential Job Functions

Coordinate Explorers League Elementary weekend services through administration of lessons, volunteer connection, family engagement, and resources

- Oversees/Coordinate Explorers League Preschool weekend services
- Ensure that current program meets the needs of children, families and volunteers
- Curriculum and Teaching
 - Coordinate large group teachers and develops overall strategy for large group. Teaches large group as needed
 - Leads transmission of weekly curriculum both the leader and children's materials
 - o Produces curriculum selections in coordination with Small Group Activities Coordinator
- Volunteer Support
 - o Equip, advise, and encourage Elementary volunteers
 - o Coordinate and manage the weekly volunteer schedule and communications (Matrix)
 - Assures volunteers have postcards and that completed ones get to Ministry Assistant
 - o Foster a spiritually healthy and fun culture within the EL volunteers
