DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- When do you start celebrating Christmas—putting up lights, decorating the tree, etc.? What other ways do you decorate?
- Isaiah 9:6, the verse on the In-N-Out Burger cup, *“For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”* Which of these titles for Jesus that Isaiah uses means the most to you and why?
- Why do you suppose so many of the people in Jesus' day loved the way He taught?
- When Jesus said He was the light of the world, what do you think He wanted his hearers to understand?
- How has His light impacted your life?
- What do you suppose Jesus meant when He said, "You are the light of the world"? What are you doing to let your light shine this season?
- Who has blessed your life recently and what did they do?
- Are you sometimes a "blessing hoarder"? How?
