- Dr. S. Joshua Swamidass said, "Without the physical Resurrection, two thousand years of history are left begging for explanation..." What were some of the unanswerable questions he raised?
- Pastor Bob said, whether you believe it is true or not, we should all hope that Easter **is** true. What reasons did Pastor Bob give for that statement; what benefits would be lost if Easter were not true?
- What price did Christ pay for you? Why do you suppose he was willing to pay such a high price for you? How does that make you feel?
- How would you answer someone who asks you, is it true and, how do you know?
