## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS'

- Bryon said good shepherds feed, lead, direct and correct. Why is each important?
- Why do you suppose Jesus so frequently used sheep and shepherds as illustrations?
- What did Bryon mean when he called Jesus an "invested owner" and what does that mean?
- The Bible tells us it is important that we recognize the voice of the GOOD Shepherd. How do we differentiate his voice from all the other voices in our lives?
- Though his listeners were not yet aware of what he meant, what was so important about Jesus' statement that a good shepherd would lay down his life for his sheep?
- What are some of the benefits you have already experienced being one of His sheep?
- What is one area in your life today where you desperately need the Good Shepherd?

Take some alone time this week and read Psalm 23 and ask the Shepherd to point out what he especially wants you to see in the chapter.
