DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1 Corinthians 10:6 warns us to "keep from setting our hearts on evil things."

 Despite our best efforts, do we sometimes set our hearts on the evil (or wrong) things?
- In 1 Corinthians 10:8-10, Paul implores us "and do not grumble..."

 Do you find yourself grumbling now when listening to or watching the news?
- Do we find ourselves ignoring idolatry, or do we do as Paul asks in verse 14 to "flee from idolatry"?
- We all have times when temptation enters our minds. Scott taught that those thoughts
 are placed in our minds by the Devil. Have you ever thought about that?
- Scott encouraged us to take captive of our thoughts. Talk about how you do that.
- Have you been honest with God and asked Him to show you where you are the most vulnerable to temptation?
- Discuss these quotes from Scott: "What we feed thrives, what we starve dies."
 "Every time you say "yes" to a temptation there is a consequence."

Take some time this week and reflect on "... we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ." (2 Corinthians 10:5). Make a list of what thoughts you need to take captive.
