## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How did Paul remind the Corinthians of who they are in I Corinthians 1:18-31? How is this relevant today? Give some examples.
- How do we bring wisdom into our daily life with humility? Talk about practical ways you can do that in the home, workplace, and in our church community.
- Pastor Bryon quoted Charles Spurgeon, *“There is no fool so great a fool as a knowing fool. But to know how to use knowledge is to have wisdom.”* What are your thoughts about what Spurgeon says about fools, knowledge, and wisdom?
- Why is worldly wisdom worthless?
- What other verses in the Bible can help you preach trust to yourself besides, Proverbs 3:5 and James 1:6.
- Where do you primarily go first when you need wisdom? Why?
- Is there anything new you have learned lately? What are some ways you can be intentional about being a life-long learner?
