DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Share a time you were totally blown away by something that happened—a gift you received, an experience, surprise visit or a trip.
- Why do you think Mary was called blessed by all generations?
- Share as many things as you can together that you know and/or learned about Mary—her response to Gabriel, her questions, her struggle, her fears etc.
- Describe a time in your journey when you had a face to face encounter with truth, a time when you sensed the Holy Spirit was giving you a God-sized task. How closely did your response reflect Mary's response?
- Pastor Bob referenced the song *Let it Be*, what would it look like for you to trust God in your current circumstances and “let it be.” (Luke 1:38)
- Go back to the last place you sensed Jesus asking you to trust Him. What is one phrase you could write that could be a part of your own Magnificat.

NEXT STEPS

Read all of Luke 1 this week, and read verses 46-55 each day. Make an ongoing list of the ways God has been mindful, mighty, and mercy-full to you.
