Position Summary:

As the Technical Director, your primary role is to support the church's mission and vision through the Production Team, operating under the direction of the Worship + Production Director. Your responsibilities include collaborating with the Production Team to program, install, and maintain production equipment across all campuses, and video venue community sites. On weekends, you will be present on-site for production during worship services. Additionally, you will oversee and manage technical staff and interns, handle technical aspects of the Online Campus, and ensure seamless execution of sound, video, and lighting production for Cornwall Church's weekend services and events.

Join Cornwall Church in Bellingham, Washington, located in the beautiful Pacific Northwest. At Cornwall we are passionate about helping people find and follow Jesus. Key Responsibilities:

- Lead the production teams at Cornwall Church and maintain a high-level experience within a distraction-free, Holy Spirit lead environment in person and online.
- Provide leadership and support to Campus Technical Directors that will include regular 1-to-1 weekly meetings and guiding professional and personal development of your team members.
- Build tech team and volunteer core teams by cultivating unity through church vision, values, and a life that points to Jesus.
- Collaborate with the Creative Arts team and specifically the Worship Director to execute weekend worship service that help people take their next step with Jesus.
- Drive the enhancement of current production and operational standards, optimize systems and execution of audio production, and lead the exploration of innovative approaches for the production team to craft impactful and purposeful productions.
- Point of contact for ministries needing production support

- Program lighting consoles and ProPresenter as needed
- Manage a centralized inventory of Production equipment
- Manage and maintain a regular maintenance schedule
- Execute projects on production systems
- Responsible for managing all live and online production systems and platforms.
- Provides production support for holiday services and run-throughs including Christmas, Easter, Refuge Worship Nights, The Global Leadership Summit, In-house conferences, funerals and more
- Train volunteers to operate systems
- Oversee the Tech Budget
- Confidentiality – keeping shared personal or leadership-level details in strict confidence.
- Attend bi-weekly All Staff Meetings
- Represent the “One Church” vision of Cornwall by being available to help local churches with technical issues or requests.
- Agreement with the vision, strategy, and direction of Cornwall Church; and as a staff person in agreement with and active participant in our ministry strategy, staff values, and staff expectations as primarily outlined in the Cornwall Church Employee Personnel Policies, Guidelines and Procedures Handbook.
