- Why would it be important for us to consider “provoking” someone we care about?
- When we “provoke” others in the name of Christ, what should our objective be?
- Could you share when someone “provoked” you in a loving way that caused positive change?

Pray this week that God would give you the courage to love people around you enough to do the uncomfortable, if needed, to help them be more like Jesus.
